### **Daily Cleaning:**

- 1. Dilute with water as follows:

#### **Neutralizing Rinse:**

After stripping or to neutralize ice melting compounds, dilute product 1/2 ounce per gallon of water. Rinse floor thoroughly. Allow floor to dry completely before re-applying seal and finish. **DIRECTIONS FOR GENERAL CLEANING** 

# (Automatic scrubber and mop & bucket method)

- Dilute 1:128 (1 oz. per gallon of water) in holding tank. Dilute 2 oz./gal for heavy build up.
  Operate Automatic Scrubber on floor in traditional manner.
- 3. Empty holding tank and re-fill with clean water.
- 4. Repeat procedure with Automatic Scrubber.
- 5. Allow floor to dry thoroughly.
