### FIRST AID

**IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. **IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. Use this product on hard, nonporous surfaces in: Health Care Facilities, institutions, athletic facilities, hotels and locker rooms. Use on washable hard, nonporous surfaces of: counters, floors, garbage cans, doorknobs and telephones.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is not for use on medical device surfaces.

### DISINFECTION/CLEANING/DEODORIZING DIRECTIONS:

Remove visible soil deposits from surface. Then visibly wet surface with a use-solution of ½ ounce of concentrate per gallon of water or equivalent. The use-solution can be applied with a cloth, mop, sponge, or coarse spray, or soaking. For sprayer applications, use a coarse spray device. Spray 6-8 inches from the surface. Do not breathe spray. Let solution remain visibly wet on surface for a minimum of 10 minutes. Rinse or allow to air dry. Rinsing of floors is not necessary unless they are to be waxed or polished. For SARS-CoV-2, treated surfaces<sup>8</sup> must remain visibly wet for 1 minute. Food contact surfaces must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water. This product must not be used to clean the following food contact surfaces: utensils, glassware and dishes.

Prepare a fresh solution daily or more often if the solution becomes visibly dirty or diluted.

**Personal Protection:** Disposable protective gloves, gowns, face masks, and eye coverings as appropriate must be worn during all cleaning of blood/body fluids and during decontamination procedures.

**Cleaning Procedures:** Blood/body fluids must be visibly cleaned from surfaces/ objects before application of disinfectant.

**Contact Time:** Mix ½ oz. of this product per gallon of water. HIV-1 (AIDS virus) is inactivated after a contact time of 4 minutes at 25°C (77°F). HBV and HCV are inactivated after a 10 minute contact time. Use appropriate contact time as listed on label for all other viruses, bacteria and fungi cleaned.

**Disposal of Infectious Materials:** Blood/body fluids must be autoclaved and disposed of according to federal, state, and local regulations for infectious waste disposal.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **Pesticide Storage:** Open dumping is prohibited. Store in original container in areas inaccessible to children.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
